Marcel Duclos was born in the French speaking community of Manchester, New Hampshire in 1939. Marcel majored in philosophy for his undergraduate studies in Massachusetts. After completing theological studies, he was ordained as a Catholic priest. He



later became a professor at the New Hampshire Technical Institute, eventually becoming a pioneer in mental health treatment and substance abuse counseling. In addition to all her other skills, Debbo is a Reiki master and a craniosacral therapist.
